## **Eligibility:**

- Experience or interest in education policy
- Enthusiasm and takes initiative

## **Responsibilities:**

- Meet bi-monthly with ERC staff
- Ability to work independently and remotely to project completion
- Must be able to take initiative, be creative, and be a problem solver
- Engage in and recruit for ERC activities
- Proficient in at least one of the following areas:
  - Website and technology
  - Marketing and recruitment
  - Event planning
  - Mentoring of undergraduate students
  - Project management
- Approximately 5 hours a week

Ambassadors will help to expand ERC operations and build capacity. They will get early access to some initial research-type opportunities, though not guaranteed. This is a great way to engage with the ERC, understand how to establish partnerships and build engagement, and develop your CV moving forward.
